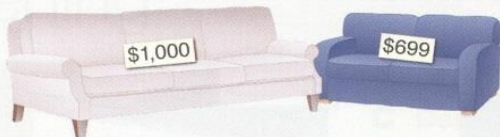

### Comparatives

big	→	bigger
cheap	→	cheaper
heavy	→	heavier
pretty	→	prettier
small	→	smaller

comfortable	→	more comfortable
expensive	→	more expensive
good	→	better

### Answers

The blue sofa is **smaller**.

The white sofa is **more expensive**.

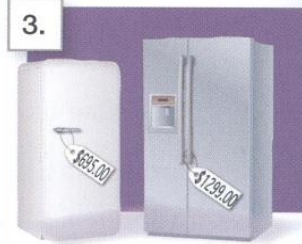
